
Troop 67 Organization






Scout Gear

- Hiking boots


























Rank Advancement

- Scouts advance on their own timetable
- Troop does not all rank up at the same time as they did in Cub Scouts
- Rank Advancement activities are conducted both independently and during troop events
- Meetings with the Scout Master and Board of Review

















- Merit Badges available in a variety of topics
- Scouts will need a certain number of Merit Badges for rank advancement
- Specific Merit Badges are required for Eagle Rank

Process

- Scouts speak to the Scout Master and request a blue card
- Blue card has three parts
 - the counselor's record
 - the scout's record
 - the troop recorder's record
- Must retain the scout's record- keep in a safe place





Court of Awards

- Bi-annual event typically held in June and October
- Scouts are recognized for rank advancements and merit badges
